

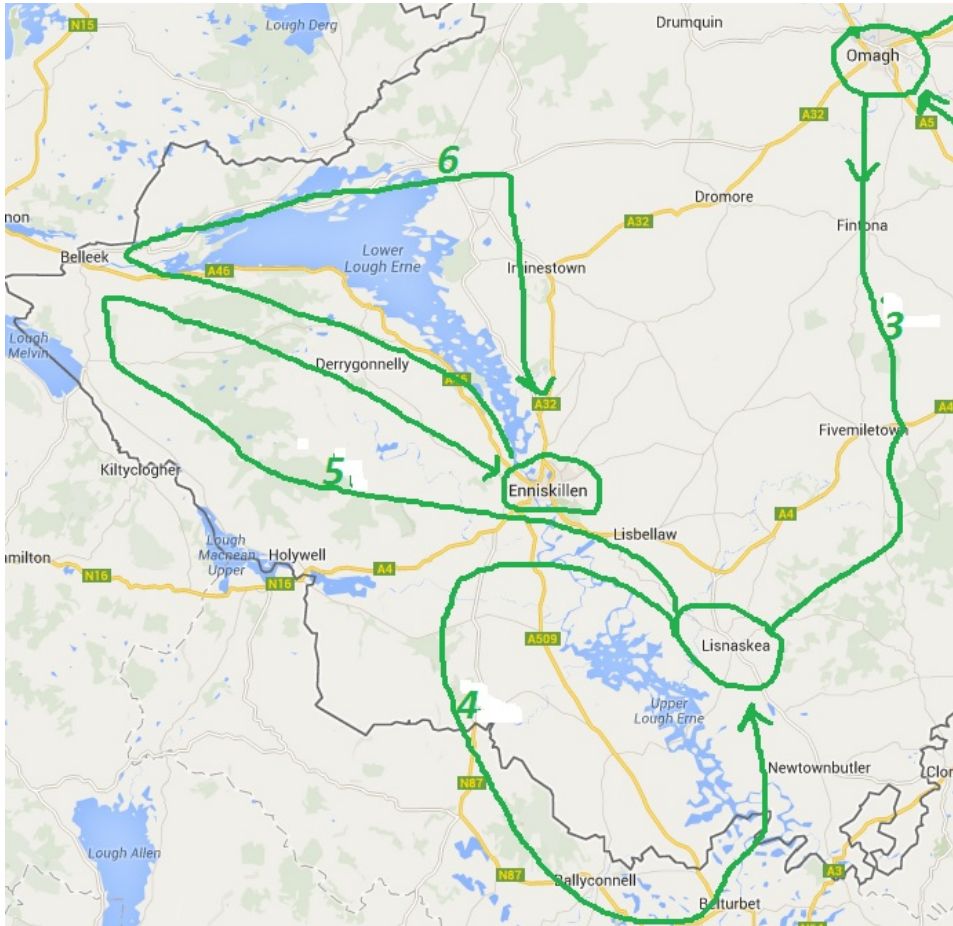
Summary: Fermanagh and Tyrone: Lakes and Glens
